

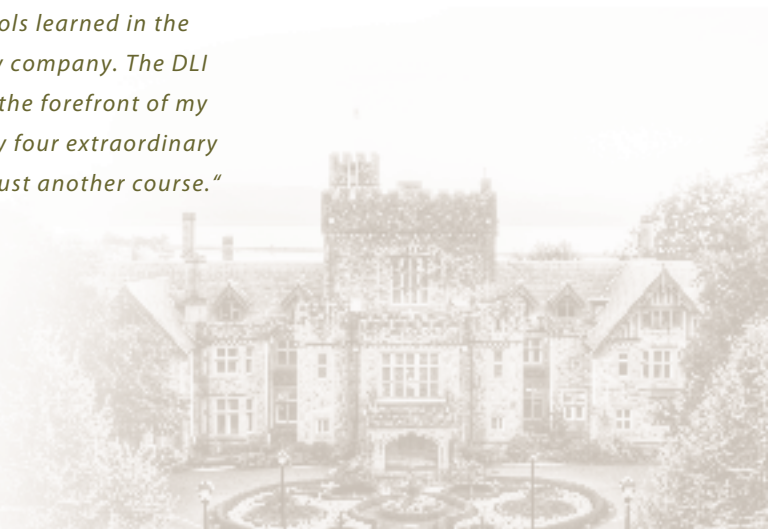
DEVELOPING LEADERSHIP IMPACT
