

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

THE GEORGIAN COLLEGE OF APPLIED ARTS AND TECHNOLOGY
(herein referred to as “GC”)

- and -

Royal Roads University
(herein referred to as the “University”)

A. BACKGROUND

- A.1 GEORGIAN COLLEGE is a community college operating at various locations in the Province of Ontario.
- A.2 Royal Roads University is a fully accredited and degree granting university operating at various locations in the Province of British Columbia.
- A.3 Georgian College offers to its students the following 2 year programs: **Business, Business -Accounting, Business - Marketing, and the following 3 year programs: Business Administration, Business Administration – Accounting, Business Administration – Marketing,** (herein referred to as the “GC Program”).
- A.4 The University offers to its students a Post Graduate **Bachelor of Commerce in Entrepreneurial Management** (herein referred to as the “University Program”) and is empowered to grant degrees to the graduates of the University Program.

B. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this Agreement include, but are not limited to:

- B.1 Ensuring access by qualified graduates of the GC Program to the University Program.
- B.2 Establishment of criteria to determine eligibility of GC graduates to the University Program
- B.3 Establishment of processes to encourage, review and expand, as appropriate, the articulation agreement between GC and the University.

C. AGREEMENT

- C.1 The University agrees to accept in the University Program GC graduates of the GC Program who meet the criteria set out in Schedule “A” of this Agreement.
- C.2 Each of GC and the University agrees to encourage GC students to participate in this articulation program by providing information and assistance to prospective transfer students.
- C.3 Each of GC and the University will designate a Program Representative at its respective campus to facilitate co-ordination of this agreement.

D. TERM OF AGREEMENT

- D.1 This Agreement will become effective on the **1st** day of **May, 2005**, and shall have a term of **five** years, automatically renewable thereafter on a year to year basis unless at least twelve (12) months notice of termination in writing is provided by either party to the other.
- .2 In the event of the termination of this Agreement under Section D.1, both parties acknowledge and agree that, subject to the qualification requirements set out in Schedule “A”, all students enrolled in the GC Program as at the date of such termination shall be entitled to admission to the University Program under this Agreement despite its termination upon their graduation from GC so as to ensure the fulfilment of the reasonable expectations of such students.
- D.3 Each institution must inform the other if substantive changes in curriculum (greater than 25%) are being determined.

E. GENERAL

E.1 Any notice or notices required to be given hereunder to either party shall effectively be given if delivered personally or sent by prepaid registered mail, mailed in the Province of Ontario, to the parties as follows:

Articulation Agreement between Georgian College and Royal Roads University

GC Programs:

2 year programs

- Business
- Business -Accounting
- Business - Marketing

3 year programs

- Business Administration
- Business Administration – Accounting
- Business Administration – Marketing

Royal Roads University Degree: Bachelor of Commerce in Entrepreneurial Management

Royal Roads University agrees to facilitate the block transfer of students from Georgian College with appropriate prerequisite qualifications into the 3rd year of the Bachelor of Commerce in Entrepreneurial Management Degree.

As a partner to the agreement, Royal Roads University agrees:

- To provide students holding a course profile similar to that given above from GC with academic acceptance into the third year of the Bachelor of Commerce program at RRU
- Whenever possible, to count any undefined transfer credits towards the Bachelor of Commerce requirements to avoid students from having to unnecessarily take additional courses to qualify for graduation
- To provide GC with updated information about the RRU Bachelor of Commerce program on an annual basis
- To notify GC with as much lead time as possible about any changes to the Bachelor of Commerce requirements that are anticipated or approved

As a partner to the agreement, Georgian College agrees:

- To make information about this agreement and the RRU Commerce degree options available to students
- To provide opportunity for representatives of RRU to visit appropriate forums at GC to disseminate information about the RRU Bachelor of Commerce program.

Royal Roads University retains the right to limit the number of students admitted under this agreement.
