Remarried

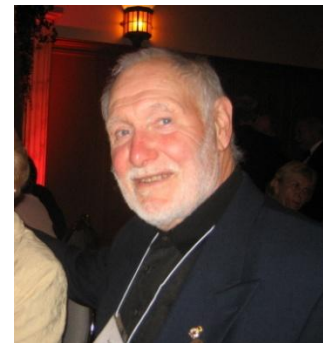
In my 80th year
